1) What are your concerns about being an Assistant Governor in 2021-22?

Expressed concerns:

- A) Computer/Internet/IT/Tech demands
- B) Will we be able to get together for service projects? The complications of service projects and when we will be able to meet in person for projects
- C) The uncertainty of when the pandemic will end makes gathering and planning difficult
- D) Different club cultures – both size and culture and how to handle the different cultures
- E) Getting Pes to set and input Goals online

2) How do we encourage Pes to put goals online? Why do PEs have trouble goals & putting them in Club Runner?

- A) May have trouble if afraid to negative reactions if goals are not achieved
- B) There may not be much reward for making goals

3) What can we do to help?

- A) Suggest to reach out.
